PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon. Meanwhile at 4:00AM today, the tropical depression outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 1,610 km east of Mindanao (9.0°N, 141.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 kph.
