### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "KAREN" was estimated based on all available data at 335 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.0°N, 127.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 75 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 95 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 13 kph.
