At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "Crising" was estimated based on all available data at 50 km East Southeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.4°N, 125.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 62 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 17 kph.
