MISAMIS ORIENTAL particularly Odiongan, Gingoog, Balatocan, Cabulig, Lower Tagaloan, Lower/Middle Western Cagayan, Iponon and Alubijid. BUKIDNON particularly Upper Tagaloan and Upper/Eastern Cagayan. MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran.

DAVAO OCCIDENTAL particularly Panglan, Malita, Batanan (Lais, Lawan, Latuan, Calian, Lamita, Lawayon, Culama, Caburan Bi, Maubio, Karabana, Tubayo, Kayapung, Malala, Capisolo, Tanoman Bi, Tanoman Smal, Kalbay, Butua, Nuin, Butula, Baki, Malagupo, Balagona and Batulaki. COMPOSTELA VALLEY particularly Matibo and Hijo. DAVAO DEL SUR particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.

 AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.
