At 4:00 PM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 780 km east of Mindanao (9.0°N, 134.0°E). Tail-end of a cold front affecting Bicol Region. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern, Central and the rest of Southern Luzon.
