PRESENT WEATHER:

At **4:00 AM**, the eye of Typhoon "NONA" was located based on all available data including Tagaytay and Iloilo Doppler Radar at **40 km North Northeast of Romblon, Romblon (12.9°N, 122.4°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **140 kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **170 kph**. It is forecast to move West at **15 kph**.
