PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 4:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "NONA" WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA INCLUDING TAGAYTAY DOPPLER RADAR OVER STA. CRUZ, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO (13.2°N, 120.8°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 140 KPH NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 170 KPH. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST AT 11 KPH.
