PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "AMANG" (MEKKHALA) was estimated based on all available data at 950 km Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.4°N, 134.4°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 19 kph.
