PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the Tropical Storm "AMANG" (MEKKHALA) was estimated based on all available data at 765 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.7°N, 132.7°E). It is forecast to move West Northwest at 19 kph.

The region CARAGA and Eastern Visayas will experience cloudy skies with light to moderate rains while the rest of Visayas and Mindanao will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rains.
