WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan EASTERN SAMAR particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat NORTHERN SAMAR particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan SAMAR particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan
