PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "KAREN" was estimated based on all available data at 125 km Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes (14.3°N, 125.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 180 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 13 kph.
