No. 04 for ARMM (Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao)


FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• MAGUINDANAO particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang, and Lower Mlang.• LANAO DEL SUR particularly Dapao and Mataling.• BASILAN particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
