PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM, the eye of Typhoon NONA was located based on all available data including Tagaytay Doppler Radar at 125 km Northwest of Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro (14.0°N, 120.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 9 kph. Meanwhile, at 2:00AM, the Tropical Depression outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated at 1425 km East Southeast of Mindanao (6.6°N, 138.7°E)
