PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "NONA" was estimated based on all available data including Tagaytay and Subic Doppler Radars at 70 km Southwest of SBMA, Olongapo City, Zambales (14.4°N, 119.8°E). It is forecast to move Northwest at 7 kph. At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "Onyok" was estimated based on all available data at 860 KM East of Mati City, Davao Oriental (7.5°N, 134.0°E). It is forecast to move West Northwest at 20 KPH.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.
