**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "AMANG" (MEKKHALA) was estimated based on all available data at 575 km East of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (12.0°N, 130.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 75 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 90 kph. It is forecast to move West at 19 kph. Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon.
