### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM Today, the center of tropical depression "HENRY" was estimated based on all available data at 200 km East – Southeast of Calayan, Cagayan (18.8 N, 123.3 E) with maximum sustained winds of 60 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 75 KM/H. Moving West at 35 KM/H. Meanwhile, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 200 KM East Southeast of Calayan, Cagayan (18.8 N, 123.3 E). Southwest Monsoon affecting the Western Section of the country.
