PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, Typhoon "LANDO" was located based on all available data at 670 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.5°N, 127.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 150 kph. It is forecast to move West at 15 kph. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

CAMARINES SUR particularly Lower Kilbay-Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang, and Lagonoy. SORSOGON particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan), and Matnog. CATANDUANES particularly Cabuyan, Bato, and Pajo. MASBATE particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada), and Beleno.

No. 01 for Region VI (WESTERN VISAYAS)

ANTIQUE particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas, and Tibiao. CAPIZ particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon, and Balantian. AKLAN particularly Ibajay, Aklan, and Jalo. NEGORS OCCIDENTAL particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay, Lower Ilog, Hilabangan, Upper Ilog, and Binalbagan.

No. 02 for Region VIII (EASTERN VISAYAS)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains with isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and itsTributaries in: SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan. LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan-Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbangaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan. EASTERN SAMAR particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat. SAMAR particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan. NORTHERN SAMAR particularly Catarman, Bungko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay.

No. 01 for Region CAR (CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: ABRA particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, and Ikmin. BENGUET particularly Upper Bauang. MT. PROVINCE, IFUGAO, AND KALINGA APAYAO particularly Upper Abulug and Upper Pamplona.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to take precautionary measures and be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.
