PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm “URDUJA” (KAI-TAK) was estimated based on all available data at the vicinity of Matuguinao, Samar (12.2°N, 124.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 110 km/h. It is forecast to move West at 13 km/h.

No. 08 for Region VI (Western Visayas)

No. 12 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

No. 12 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate with occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eastern Samar particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • Leyte particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • Northern Samar particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay. • Southern Leyte particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Samar particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • Biliran rivers and its tributaries

No. 10 for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

No. 10 for Region X (Northern Mindanao)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lanao Del Norte particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan and Maranding. • Misamis Occidental particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran. • Misamis Oriental particularly Odiongan, Gingoog, Balatocan, Cabulig, Lower Tagaloan, Lower/Middle Western Cagayan, Iponon and Alubijid.

No. 13 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Surigao Del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes.• Agusan del Norte particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.• Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet• Surigao Del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.• Agusan del Sur particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.
