Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Palawan, Visayas, and Mindanao.

No. 03 for Region VI (WESTERN VISAYAS)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains with isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and itsTributaries in: Iloilo particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro, Agaman, Sibalom, and Guimbal ANTIQUE particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas, and Tibiao. CAPIZ particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay, Malinao, Alingon, and Balantian. AKLAN particularly Ibajay, Aklan, and Jalo. NEGROS OCCIDENTAL particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay, Lower Ilog, Hilabangan, Upper Ilog, and Binalbagan.

No. 17 for Region VIII (EASTERN VISAYAS)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains with isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES	 Rivers and itsTributaries in: SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan-Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pangbangaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan.
AFFECTED	 <u>Eastern Samar</u> particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat. <u>SAMAR</u> particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan. <u>Northern Samar</u> particularly Catarman, Bungko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay.

No. 03 (FINAL) for Region X (NORTHERN MINDANAO)

LANAO DEL NORTE particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan and Maranding.

No. 14 (FINAL) for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and itsTributaries in: SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bisig AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan, and Andanan DINAGAT ISLAND particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are still advised to take precautionary measures for possible flashfloods and landslides.
