**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "GENER" was located based on all available data at 335 KM North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23.3°N, 123.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 165 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 200 kph. It is forecast to move north at 17 kph.
