**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Depression "ONYOK" was estimated based on all available data at 405km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.4°N, 130.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center. It is forecast to move West at 17 kph. Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon.
