PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "AMANG" (MEKKHALA) was estimated based on all available data at 45 km Northwest of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.7°N, 124.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move Northwest at 15 kph.
