PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "LANDO" was located based on all available data including Baler Doppler Radar in the vicinity of Casiguran, Aurora (15.9°N, 121.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 175 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 210 kph. It is forecast to move West at 3 kph.

No. 01 for NCR (NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Low lying areas in Metro Manila.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.
