Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Palawan, Visayas, and Mindanao.

No. 07 for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasional moderate rains with isolated thunderstorms.
