<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b><u>Agusan del Sur</u></b> particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan, and Andanan.</li><li>• <b><u>Surigao del Norte</u></b> particularly Surigao and Magallanes.</li><li>• <b><u>Dinagat Islands</u></b> particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.</li><li>• <b><u>Agusan del Norte</u></b> particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran.</li><li>• <b><u>Surigao del Sur</u></b> particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.</li></ul>
