### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the **center** of Typhoon "LANDO" was located based on all available data including **Aparri Doppler Radar** in the vicinity of **Tinoc, Ifugao (16.7°N, 120.9°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **120 kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **150 kph**. It is forecast to move **North Northeast at 5 kph**.
