### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the Center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 665 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.9°N, 132.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. It is moving West Northwest at 15 km/h. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
