PRESENT WEATHER:

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON SOULIK WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,670 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (25.6°N, 137.3°E) [OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 150 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 185 KM/H. MOVING WEST NORTHWEST 20KM/H.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• IFUGAO – all rivers and its tributaries.• APAYAO – particularly Upper Abulug.• BENGUET – particularly Upper Bauang.• ABRA – particularly Upper Abra, Tineg and Ikmin.• MOUNTAIN PROVINCE – all rivers and its tributaries.• KALINGA – all rivers and its tributaries.
