



ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC Advisory was disseminated to **OCD/RDRRMCs III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, XI, XII, and CARAGA** through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
