PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "LANDO" was estimated based on all available data at 130 KM Northwest of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (19.0°N, 119.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 95 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 120 kph. It is forecast to move Northeast at 5 kph.
