**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "LAWIN" was located based on all available data including Aparri Doppler Radar at vicinity of Kabugao, Apayao (18.0° N, 121.1°E) with maximum sustained winds up to 205 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 285 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 25 kph.
