No. 11 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. • DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. • SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig. • AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan, and Andanan.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
