PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of the typhoon "Ineng" was located based on all available data at 170 km East of Calayan, Cagayan (19.1°N, 123.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 170 KPH near center and gustiness of up to 205 KPH. It is forecast to move west northwest at 7 KPH.
