No. 03 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EASTERN SAMAR - particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • LEYTE - particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • NORTHERN SAMAR - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • SOUTHERN LEYTE - particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • SAMAR - particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • BILIRAN - all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 02 (FINAL) for Region XIII (Caraga)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• SURIGAO DEL SUR - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.• AGUSAN DEL NORTE - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.• DINAGAT ISLANDS - particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.• SURIGAO DEL NORTE - particularly Surigao and Magallanes

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to be alerted for possible flashfloods and landslides.
