



PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Vinta" was estimated based on all available data at 520 km east of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (9.0N, 131.0E) with maximum winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is forecast to move west at 18 km/h. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Southern Luzon.

No. 5 for Region II (Cagayan Valley)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Isabela particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican and Palanan-Pinacanauan. • Cagayan particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabcungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawig and Taboan. • Quirino all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 6 (Final) for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and thunderstorms
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WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aurora particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.	

No. 10 for Region IVA (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quezon particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan. • Laguna particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. • Batangas particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya). • Cavite particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus.

No. 01 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

No. 01 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eastern Samar particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • Leyte particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • Northern Samar particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay. • Southern Leyte Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Samar particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan.

No. 01 for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. • ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco. • ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.

No. 01 for Region X (Northern Mindanao)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Misamis Occidental particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran. • Lanao Del Norte particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan and Maranding. • Misamis Oriental particularly Odiongan, Gingoog, Balatocan, Cabulig, Lower Tagaloan, Lower/Middle Western Cagayan, Iponon and Alubijid. • Bukidnon particularly Upper Tagaloan and Upper/Eastern Cagayan.

No. 2 for Region XI (Davao Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate with occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Davao Del Norte particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang. • Compostela Valley particularly Matibo and Hijo. • Davao Oriental particularly Cateel, Dapnan, Baganga, Mahanub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casauman, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya and Sumlao/Cuabo. • Davao Del Sur particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya, Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit. • Davao Occidental particularly Panglan, Malita, Batanan (Lais, Lawan, Latuan, Calian, Lamita, Lawayon, Culama, Caburan Bi, Maubio, Karabana, Tubayo, Kayapung, Malala, Capisolo, Tanoman Smal, Kalbay, Butua, Nuin, Butula, Baki, Malagupo, Balagona, Batulaki.

No. 01 for Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sarangani particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian. • South Cotabato particularly Siquil, Makar and Banaga. • Sultan Kudarat particularly Tian and Kraan. • North Cotabato particularly Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi.

No. 2 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surigao Del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • Agusan del Norte particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. • Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet • Surigao Del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig. • Agusan del Sur particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.

No. 01 for ARMM

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maguindanao particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang and Lower Mlang. • Basilan particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang. • Lanao Del Sur particularly Dapao and Mataling.
