No. 03 for Region IV (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LAGUNA - particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal • RIZAL - particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa • Quezon – particularly Upper Umiray, Lower bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper kilbay-Catabangan

No. 04 for Region V (BICOL REGION)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CATANDUANES- particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo • ALBAY –particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol • CAMARINES NORTE - particularly Labo and Daet Basud • MASBATE –particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno • CAMARINES SUR - particularly lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy. • SORSOGON particularly lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog.

No. 44 for Region VIII (EASTERN VISAYAS)

No. 1 for Region X (NORTHERN MINDANAO)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LANAO DEL NORTE particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan, and Maranding. • MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran. • MISAMIS ORIENTAL particularly Odiongan, Gingoog, Balatocan, Cabulig, Lower Tagaloan, Lower/Middle Western Cagayan, Iponon and Alubijid. • BUKIDNON particularly Upper Tagaloan and Upper/Eastern Cagayan

No. 15 for Region XI (DAVAO REGION)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DAVAO DEL SUR particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit. • DAVAO DEL NORTE particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang. • COMPOSTELA VALLEY particularly Matibo and Hijo • DAVAO ORIENTAL particularly Catul, Dapras, Bangaga, Mahaneb, Manurigao, Caraga, Casaunan, Quinonoan, Bugnan-Mayo, Bitanayan and Sumlog.

No. 11 for Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SULTAN KUDARAT – Tian and Kraan. • SARANGANI particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian • NORTH COTABATO particularly Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi.

No. 16 for Region 13 (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes • SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig • AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. • DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.

No. 12 for Region ARMM (AUTONOMOUS REGION OF MUSLIM MINDANAO)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LANAO DEL SUR particularly Dapao and Mataling • MAGUINDANAO particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang and Lower Mlang

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
