At 4:00 PM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 190 KM Northeast of Casiguran, Aurora (17.4°N, 123.5°E). Meanwhile, the eye of the typhoon "GORING" was located based on all available data at 1,390 KM East Northeast of Basco Batanes (24.7°N, 134.7°E).
