At 4:00 AM today, the low pressure area (FORMERLY: LANDO) was estimated based on all available data at 285 KM East of Basco, Batanes (20.6°N, 124.7°E).

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BATAAN particularly Balanga and Moron. • AURORA particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray • ZAMBALES particularly Panatawan, Sto.Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis. • BULACAN particularly Angat, Marilao, Meycauayan, and Sta. Maria.

No. 08 (FINAL) for CAR (CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION)

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light rains
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ABRA particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, and Ikmin. • BENGUET particularly Upper Bauang. • MT. PROVINCE, IFUGAO, AND KALINGA • APAYAO particularly Upper Abulug and Upper Pamplona.
Unless significant rainfall occurs, this is the Final General Flood Advisory for this event.
