PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting Visayas and Mindanao. Meanwhile, at 4:00 PM today, the Tropical Storm DUJUAN outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 1,465 km East of Luzon (19.6 N, 135.5 E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center with gustiness of 80 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 kph.
