At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "DINDO" was located based on all available data at 1,165KM East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (24.7°N, 132.2°E). It is forecast to move South Southwest at 7KPH. Southwest Monsoon affecting the western section of Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.
