PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION "LUIS" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 505 KM NORTH NORTHWEST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.7 °N, 120.3 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH AT 10 KM/H. MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA WAS ESTIMATED AT 1,055 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (22.0 °N, 132.0°E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.
