PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, Typhoon "Niña" was located based on all available data at 575 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.1N, 129.5E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 135 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 165 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 17 kph. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

No. 04 for Region XIII (CARAGA)
