#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of TY Marilyn was located based on all available data at 1,275 km east of Calayan, Cagayan (19.2°N, 133.6°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness up to 160 kph. It is forecast to move northeast at 13 kph.
