**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 60 km East Southeast of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.6°N, 126.0°E) with maximum winds of 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 55 kph. It is forecast to move Northwest at 19 kph.
