



### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **4:00 AM** today, **Typhoon "Nina"** was located based on all available data including Guiuan and Virac Doppler radar at **250 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.6N, 126.5E)** with **maximum sustained winds of up to 175 kph** near the center and **gustiness of up to 215 kph**. It is forecast to move **West at 15 kph**.
