At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Nina" was located based on all available data including Virac Doppler radar at 85 km North of Romblon, Romblon (13.3N, 122.2E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 150 kph near the center and questiness of up to 250 kph. It is forecast to move West at 20 kph.
