At 4:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 465 KM east of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.6°N, 129.7°E). It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao.
