**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 125 km Northwest of Coron, Palawan (12.7°N, 119.3°E) with maximum winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move Northwest at 15 kph.
