PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of typhoon “Jenny” was estimate based on all available data **965 km East of Itbayat, Batanes (20.0°N, 131.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph.** It is forecast to move Northwest at 9 kph. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
