PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon “Jenny” was located based on all available data at 785 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (21.8°N, 129.3°E), with maximum sustained winds of 140 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 170 KPH. It is forecast to move Northwest at 15 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
